


# Promise centre prospectus

**What we do:** Here at promise centre, we provide nonstop tuition, fast-track courses and workshop for KS1-KS4. We have created diverse classes to meet diverse needs at key stages of an individual's educational life. Our services are tailor-made to suit three key areas of interest: **academic skills (developmental) tuition, attainment tuition and examination tuition.**

**Developmental tuition is created to meet a specific academic need.** When Cosmos came, he was struggling with writing sentences and crafting stories. Having understood his specific needs, we put him through our developmental tuition, the Fast Track Class (FTC) and the rest is his story. Often, this most important area of tuition is neglected and there are many students who are suffering because of not having such key skills like reading and writing skills. All we do in life requires skill. If you have knowledge without the skill to apply that knowledge, then, you will not be able to excel. Over the years, we've come across a number of students who know what they want to write about but do not possess the writing skills to compose their ideas coherently and fluently. We created this kind of tuition to meet this frustrating need.

**Attainment tuition is designed to support those students who are still lagging behind their peers.** If you are still lagging behind or under-performing in your studies or below your expected level, the attainment class will be suitable for you. Your teacher or mentor would have told you where you are and where you need to be. We will support you to move from where you are to where you need to be. First, we start by looking at why you are still where you are; what needs to be done to make sure that you reach that target and once you feel that you've reached that target, we will also assess you to know if that is the case. So, it is a 3-way framework. Under our attainment tuition, we run **ENAP: English for Newly Arrived Pupils**, which concentrates on English grammar. Pupils (NAPs) who arrive Britain from abroad including other EU countries often find it hard adapting in the UK system. At Promise Centre, we run ENAP to help them attain the levels of their peers.

**Examination tuition is devoted solely to preparing you for that examination or winning that competitive scholarship.** Start in time to prepare for any exam. Do not wait until you are 11+ to start preparing for 11+ exam likewise you do not have to wait till you are a teenager to start preparing for GCSE. Just as the name implies, we created **Test Your Knowledge Examination (TYKE)** to assess how far and how well you've gone in preparing for that next exam. We employ both oral and written tests to assess your knowledge of key subjects. Sometimes, we hold academic quiz competitions just to drive out that competitive spirit in our students and improve their speed and accuracy.

Presently, we are running 6 different classes weekly and monthly. Now, you can host a class with a neighbour, <i>who is struggling with the same academic problems or topics as you</i>. All you need to do is knock on their door and tell them about your plans for the class or workshop due for next month.
